FAST AND ABSTINENCE

ABSTINENCE: is observed on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. Meat may not be eaten at all.

Catholics over 14 years of age are bound by this obligation.

FAST: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the days of fasting - only one full meal is allowed.

Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 are bound to this obligation.

SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

Please come to the Sacrament of Penance this Lent. The Church encourages all Catholics to celebrate this Sacrament each Lent. In addition to our normal Saturday afternoon confessions from 3:00 - 3:45 in the Chapel, Immaculate Conception Parish will be open on Lenten Wednesdays from 6:30 – 7:30 pm. Please take advantage of this opportunity to go to confession. Please also reach out to Catholics you know who have been away from the regular practice of our faith and invite them to seize this chance to begin again.

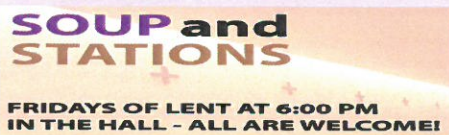

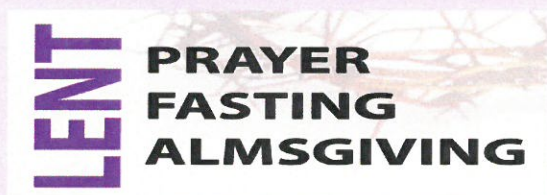
THE LIGHT IS ON FOR YOU ...
